HRTV (www.hrtv.com) is a 24-hour television network providing wire-to-wire coverage of live horse racing, originally produced series and specials relating to the sport of horse racing, general equestrian programming, and other content appealing to an audience of horse racing and equestrian enthusiasts. HRTV is available to approximately 18 million television subscribers throughout the United States and is available at www.hrtv.com.

If you are the rights holder to an event and are seeking coverage, please forward a press kit together with the relevant information about your event for our review.

Submitted materials do not have a required format. Trailers, pilots, series and demo reels can be sent in on VHS, DVD or Beta form.

Attached, please find our standard Program Submission Waiver Agreement. We will not receive, review or consider any type of proposal without a completed Program Submission Waiver Agreement.
